The NINETY NINES, INC. is an international organization of licensed women pilots from 35 countries. The organization was initiated by Amelia Earhart, and came into being November 2, 1929. She was elected first president and the group was named for the 99 charter members. Members serve in a number of charitable and philanthropic support roles to aviation activities: Sponsoring and conducting aviation safety and educational seminars, introducing young people to aviation through presentations made in school settings and introductory flights at local airports, teaching flying companion seminars, just to name a few. The organization also sponsors a number of aviation scholarships for both its members and the general aviation community.

### **Objective**

The award will be presented to the female pilot who meets the criteria listed on the application and who has achieved academic excellence, and flight proficiency in the region of the First Canadian Chapter of the 99s. The award is a special project of the First Canadian Chapter, intended to promote women in aviation.

The award consists of a one-year membership to the Ninety-Nines, a cash award of \$400.00, and a plaque, to be displayed at the flying club of the winner's choice!
